### Auction Rules and Guidance

#### Advice to Sellers.

1. Sunderlands.co.uk are administrating the Auction.
2. All items for sale, excluding live bees, are to be bought to the action 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026, from 7am to 11.30am.
3. No drawn brood comb will be accepted.
4. All Items for sale are to be listed on the entry form available at: - [www.breconandradnorbeekeepingassociation.com](http://www.breconandradnorbeekeepingassociation.com)
5. It is the seller's responsibility to indicate on the entry form and notify the booking in steward if they wish to place a reserve on an entry. Every effort will be made to ensure that this will be the minimum hammer price
6. If you wish your items to be included in the BRBKA on line catalogue, which will be available on the BRBKA website, please email the form to [Secretary@BRBKA2024.onmicrosoft.com](mailto:Secretary@BRBKA2024.onmicrosoft.com) by the 17<sup>th</sup> April. Entries after this date and on and up to the 25<sup>th</sup> will not appear on the web catalogue.
7. **Please bring a hard copy of the form with you on the day.**
8. All items must be of reasonable quality and condition. The Auctioneer has the right to refuse any entry.
9. Sellers fees: -£2 up to £20 selling price, thereafter 10% of the full selling price.
10. Sellers's payment will be via BACs, (bank details to be entered on the entry form). The payment for lots sold, will be made by Sunderlands Auctioneers and may take up to 21 days.
11. Unsold lots need to be collected by 6pm, with release docket" issued by Sunderlands.

## **Selling of Live Bees**

12. All live bees must be entered on the live bee entry form, one for each individual Nuc or brood box of bees. Available at [www.breconandradnorbeekeepingassociation.com](http://www.breconandradnorbeekeepingassociation.com)
13. Live bees must be entered by the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2026 to allow for them to be inspected by the bee inspector. **The form is to be emailed [Secretary@BRBKA2024.onmicrosoft.com](mailto:Secretary@BRBKA2024.onmicrosoft.com) and Shane Jones, [beewelshhoney@gmail.com](mailto:beewelshhoney@gmail.com)**
14. **Please bring a hard copy of the form with you on the day.**
15. The bees will be held at a secure location close to the auction site.
16. All nuc's to be sold in Correx boxes. A full colony of bees to be sold in a secure brood box, with solid floor and Travel screen.
17. Live bees cannot be collected before 6pm on the 25<sup>th</sup> April 2026.

**Sellers entering items for sale will be deemed to have accepted the rules of the auction.**

## **Advice to Buyers.**

1. Sunderlands will advise on the day, how buyers should make a bid.
2. The seller retains ownership until the fall of the hammer, when the lot becomes the responsibility of the buyer. BRBKA/Sunderlands does not accept liability for any loss or damage.
3. In the event of a disagreement the lot maybe put up for sale again at the sole discretion of the auctioneers.
4. Buyers' premium is 5% of the purchase price.
5. Payment is by cash or debit/credit card administered by Sunderlands.
6. All sold items are to be collected by 6.00pm, with a valid Auctioneers receipt/docket.
7. Buyers of live bees should bring straps for nuc/hives for transporting the bees from the auction.
8. It is highly recommended that all second-hand equipment is sterilised before use.
